COURSE CONTENT:

- Scene safety, assessment and scene leadership. Contact methods with the outside world.
- Primary and Secondary Surveys (ABCDE, SAMPLER), vital signs, incl breath sounds, RR, SPO2, PR, NIBP.
- Airway, Breathing, Circulation assessment and management ("A&M") including ("incl") methods of freeing airways, assisted ventilation, bleeding control, shock and wound management.
- Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation without an AED, choking, recovery position.
- Head, chest, abdominal, spinal and extremity trauma A&M incl splinting with traction-, flexible, improvised splints, bandaging, spine management manually, with cervical collars and spine splint.
- Medical emergency A&M incl anaphylaxis, asthma, chest pain, diabetes, drowning, epilepsy, stroke.
- Environmental emergency A&M: Basic marine envenomation and injuries, drowning, hypo- hyperthermia, cold water immersion, lightning strike.
- Burns, dental problems, eye injuries, pain management, psychological problems and management.
- Expedition challenges incl constipation, diarrhea, dehydration and hydration, genitourinary tract disorders.
- Rapid extraction as well as planned transportation of casualties.
- Familiarization with common personal and emergency medication and administration including the use of auto injector.
- Administration of intra muscular (IM) injection.
- Practical training in complex scenarios including communication with doctors and prehospital personnel.
